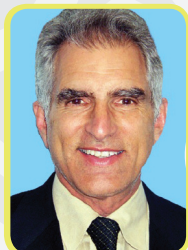

He has lectured worldwide, published and is currently an Assoc Prof of Removable Prosthodontics at the University of Pacific.

COURSE OVERVIEW:

This course will address the treatment of fully edentulous patients with tissue-supported/tissue- and implant-supported overdentures. The course will focus on the designs & attachments that can be used to treat the fully edentulous implant patient. We will also review implant-supported, cement- and screw-retained anterior restorations, treatment planning considerations & soft tissue management. Case presentations will be used during the course to demonstrate implant treatment modalities.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

At the end of this course, the participant will be able to:

1. Review the steps involved in implant-retained overdenture treatment
2. List and describe attachments that can be utilized for implant-retained and implant-supported overdentures
3. Describe the factors affecting esthetic outcomes in the anterior implant case.
4. Review the steps involved in immediate and delayed temporization
